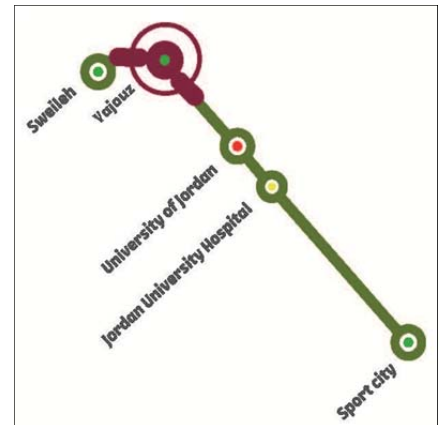


## Tender for Construction of Facilities for Amman Bus Rapid Transit System (package 3) RFP No. (46/1/2016)

The Greater Amman Municipality (GAM) announces the Tender for Package 3 Queen Rania St. and Vajouz Rd. of the Construction of Facilities for Amman Bus Rapid Transit System. The Amman BRT is a mass transit system being implemented by GAM as part of its program to enhance public transport services in the Capital Amman. The system which consists of dedicated bus lanes, modern stations, articulated buses, and state-of-the-art management and information systems will provide premium services along three corridors with a total length of 32 km.

Qualified international and local Contractors (**Road Construction Class A or Concrete Works/Bridges, Intersections and Tunnels Class A**) interested in participating in this tender may obtain copies of the Tender Documents from the Tendering and Procurement Department at the Greater Amman Municipality starting from **28 February 2016**.

- 1- Bidders may collect the tender documents from GAM Tendering and Procurement Department (second floor) by an authorized representative of the bidder who will be obliged to submit a certified official copy of the bidder's company business registration. The fee for the tender documents is (200 JD) non-refundable.
- 2- The last date for purchasing tender documents is **(Sunday) 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2016**
- 3- All inquiries should be addressed to GAM Supply Chain and Assets Directorate/ Tendering and Procurement Department at the address shown below no later than **(Sunday) 20<sup>th</sup> of March 2016**.
- 4- Proposals must be received in sealed envelopes, either delivered by hand or by courier to GAM at the address noted below **no later than Monday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2016 at (12:00) noon (Amman Local Time)**. Late responses will not be considered.
- 5- The proposal must be submitted in a single package containing three envelopes, sealed separately and clearly marked (**Tender Number, Tender Name, and Bidder Name**).
  - a. The first envelope must include the Technical Proposal in 3 hardcopies (1 original and 2 copies) and a soft copy on CD. It must be clearly marked (Tender Number, Tender Name, and Bidder Name) in addition to marking the envelope as copy or original.
  - b. The second envelope must include the Financial Proposal in 3 hardcopies (1 original and 2 copies) and a soft copy on CD. This envelope must also include the form of tender filled and duly signed by the bidder. It must be clearly marked (Tender Number, Tender Name, Bidder Name and Financial Proposal) in addition to marking the envelope as copy or original.
  - c. The third envelope must include the tender bond for the value of **(JD 135,000) one hundred thirty five thousand Jordanian Dinars**. It must be clearly marked (Tender Number, Tender Name and Bid Bond). The bond must be issued in the name of the Mayor of Amman in addition to his title, and must be valid for 120 days from the date of tender submission.
- 6- Bidders are requested to follow up the issuance of any further instructions and amendments to the RFP document.
- 7- GAM reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal, and to annul the Tender process and reject all proposals at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to Bidders.
- 8- Bidders will be advised, in due course, of the results of their proposals.
